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Introduction

The core framework acknowledges that whānau have the expertise and knowledge to achieve oranga.

The practitioners role is to navigate this journey through providing access to conducive mechanisms and tools.

Whānau ora is achieved through self determination, self empowerment and self awareness.



Te Pātaka Uara

Is a generic concept that supports Māori beliefs values and Māori identity as it relates to tradition and the current variables within whānau, communities and practitioners.

Te Pātaka refers to the storehouse that in traditional times housed specialist kai.

The Uara offers a perspective of lateral direction, foundation, concepts and principles.

From a conceptual perspective, Te Pātaka Uara refers to the resource whare of valuable content.

*He aha te mea nui o te Ao? He tangata,
he tangata he tangata!*



Aim

Te Pātaka Uara is an indigenous framework that acknowledges the valuable role whānau play in the delivery of Hauora responsiveness

Te Pātaka Uara aims to support Māori practitioners who are whānau centered and want access to a workforce pathway that recognizes the capacity of whānau to self determine.

Te Pātaka Mauri ora

Mauri ora is a concept that focuses on generating wellbeing

This Pātaka focuses on creating spaces for transformation to occur which enables whānau enhancement

Te Pātaka Uara is a step by step approach that will guide and direct the practitioner on a pathway of restoration





Te Pātaka Kaiora

Refers to the skill resources and intrinsic qualities that practitioners have to deliver a service to *our* people.

To give value to the workforce who practice toward the well-being of whānau, Te Rau Matatini extend the invitation through Te Pātaka Kaiora to be a part of an inventory plan.



Te Pātaka Aratoi

Constructive practices are a necessary component for practitioners who work in the field of whānau oranga

To Aratoi refers to the concept of path finding. As a practitioner it is necessary to navigate a number of pathways to support whānau to self-determine

Te Pātaka Aratoi regulates and guides practitioners through Te Pātaka Uara

Te Rau Matatini will provide a guideline booklet to assist practitioners to support whānau
